In Tribal communities infants, children, youth, elders, women and men are all affected by domestic violence. Domestic violence in Tribal Communities is 4 to 5 times higher than the general population.

Inter-Tribal Council of California (ITCC) 40 Hour Domestic Violence Certificated Training will provide participants with specific resources, rights and information in victim services. Training and information is intended to protect the victim/survivors and support open dialogue to provide appropriate advocacy and navigation of services from existing resources. The 40 Hour DV training incorporates key components offering awareness, knowledge, resources and mechanisms designed to serve the unique and specific diverse needs of tribes, tribal communities, urban and rural communities serving tribal people in a culturally proficient manner.

ITCC and Member Tribes have provided domestic violence advocacy for over 20 years, therefore providing a unique and thorough training. ITCC Advocates are State Certified and will be presenters for this training, as well as professionals with expertise in the field of victim services at State and local levels. ITCC's curriculum will assist domestic violence service providers to meet the requirements of a "Domestic Violence Counselor" pursuant to California Evidence Code §1037.1(a)(1)
